

DON TYSON ENDOWED SCHOLARSHIP FOR AGRICULTURE, FOOD AND LIFE SCIENCES STUDIES GUIDELINES

Springdale Public Schools Education Foundation Scholarship Program

PURPOSE

The Don Tyson Endowed Scholarship for Agriculture, Food and Life Sciences Fund provides support to students who are a graduate of an accredited public high school in Springdale, Arkansas pursuing post-secondary education at the University of Arkansas Dale Bumpers College of Agriculture, Food, and Life Sciences.

USE OF FUNDS

The Don Tyson Endowed Scholarship helps deserving students pursuing a career in agriculture continue their education by providing financial assistance for tuition and books over one academic year.

ELIGIBILITY

Qualified applicants must:

- ◆ Be graduating seniors from an accredited public high school in Springdale,
- ◆ Enroll at the University of Arkansas Dale Bumpers College of Agriculture, Food, and Life Sciences as a full-time student, and
- ◆ Have a minimum of a 3.00 GPA.

Age, race, sex, marital status or religious affiliation will have no bearing on eligibility for this scholarship.

CRITERIA

The criteria for selection of the scholarship recipient is determined by the selection committee, and may include, but not limited to, academic performance,

financial need, extracurricular activities, community involvement, and special circumstances.

AMOUNT OF SCHOLARSHIP

The amount of the scholarship is \$1,000. Changes to the scholarship amount may be determined by the Foundation based on factors including, but not limited to, the amount of dollars available from the fund.

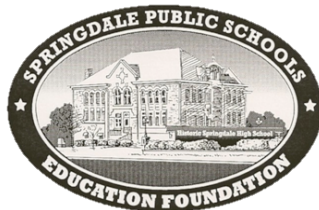
NONRENEWABLE
