

PAT R. HENRY MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINES

Springdale Public Schools Education Foundation Scholarship Program

PURPOSE

The Pat R. Henry Memorial Scholarship Fund provides scholarships to Springdale residents interested in pursuing undergraduate degree at the University of Arkansas or Hendrix College.

USE OF FUNDS

The Pat R. Henry Memorial Scholarship helps deserving students continue their education by providing financial assistance for tuition, fees, and books over one academic year.

ELIGIBILITY

Qualified applicants must be Springdale residents who are either:

- ◆ Graduating seniors from Springdale High School, with a minimum 3.0 GPA and a minimum cumulative ACT score of 24, and,
- ◆ Students enrolled as undergraduate at the University of Arkansas or Hendrix College

Age, race, sex, marital status or religious affiliation will have no bearing on eligibility for this scholarship.

CRITERIA

The criteria for selection of the scholarship recipient is determined by the selection

committee, and may include, but not limited to, academic performance, financial need, unusual circumstances, and volunteer, work, or extracurricular activities.

AMOUNT OF SCHOLARSHIP

The amount of the scholarship is \$1,000. The scholarship amount is determined annually by the Foundation based on factors including, but not limited to, the cost of tuition and fees, the pool of applicants, and the amount of dollars available from the fund.

NONRENEWABLE

This scholarship is a one-time award and is not renewable.

APPLICATION PROCESS

The application process is as follows:

1. You must complete the online application by April 1st,
2. The selection committee will review applications.
3. The recipient will be notified of final scholarship decisions at the senior assembly.
