

HAR-BER HIGH SCHOOL BAND PRIDE IN EXCELLENCE SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINES

Springdale Public Schools Education Foundation Scholarship Program

PURPOSE

The Har-Ber High School Pride in Excellence Scholarship Fund provides financial support to a graduate of Har-Ber High School pursuing post-secondary education at a college or university.

USE OF FUNDS

The Har-Ber High School Pride in Excellence Scholarship helps deserving students continue their education by providing financial assistance for tuition, books, and supplies over one academic year.

ELIGIBILITY

Qualified applicants must be:

1. Graduating seniors from Har-Ber High School
2. Enrolling at a university/college in pursuit of a four or two year degree
3. A member of the Har-Ber band program each year they attended Har-Ber High School.

Age, race, sex, marital status or religious affiliation will have no bearing on eligibility for this scholarship.

CRITERIA

The criteria for selection of the scholarship recipient is determined by the selection committee, and may include, but not limited to, leadership, financial need, academic performance, personal character and embodiment of the Band motto "Pride in Excellence".

AMOUNT OF SCHOLARSHIP

The amount of the scholarship is \$1,000. Changes to the scholarship amount may be determined by the Foundation based on factors including, but not limited to, the amount of dollars available from the fund.

RENEWABLE

This scholarship may be renewable for up to four years, providing the student maintains a 2.5 academic achievement level (on a 4.0 scale) and remains a full-time student, completing 30 credit hours per academic year.

APPLICATION PROCESS

The application process is as follows:

1. You must complete the online application by April 1st,
2. The selection committee will review applications and essays, selecting 4 to 5 qualified finalists.
3. The selection committee will interview the finalists.
4. The recipient will be notified of final scholarship decision at the Har-Ber High School Band spring concert.
