JACK & GLENNA HELLSTERN SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINES

Springdale Public Schools Education Foundation Scholarship Program

PURPOSE

The Jack and Glenna Hellstern Scholarship Fund provides scholarships to graduates of an accredited public high school in Springdale who exhibit financial need, have the ability and motivation to complete the post-secondary course of study and the willingness to work to supplement the scholarship funds received.

USE OF FUNDS

The Jack and Glenna Hellstern Scholarship helps deserving students continue their education by providing financial assistance for tuition, fees, and books for up to four years.

ELIGIBILITY

Qualified applicants must be:

- Graduating seniors from an accredited public high school in Springdale,
- Willing to work at a job during the school year to supplement the scholarship funds, and
- Enrolling at a four-year college or two-year Vocational/Technical school in pursuit of a degree.

Age, race, sex, marital status or religious affiliation will have no bearing on eligibility for this scholarship.

CRITERIA

The criteria for selection of the scholarship recipient is determined by the selection committee, and may include, but not limited to, academic performance, financial need, unusual circumstances, demonstrated leadership in school, community involvement, and character.

AMOUNT OF SCHOLARSHIP

The amount of the scholarship is \$1,000 for the 1st year award, and \$2,000 for each subsequent award. Changes to the scholarship amount may be determined by the Foundation based on factors including, but not limited to, the amount of dollars available from the fund.

RENEWABLE

This scholarship may be renewable for up to four years, providing the student maintains a 2.5 academic achievement level (on a 4.0 scale) and remains a full-time student, completing 30 credit hours per academic year.

APPLICATION PROCESS

The application process is as follows:

- 1. You must complete the online application by April 1st.
- 2. The selection committee will review applications.
- 3. The recipient will be notified of final scholarship decisions at the senior assembly.
- 4. The recipient must attend the Donor & Scholar Reception during the first week of June.



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
