

HAROLD E. HENSON SR. SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINES

Springdale Public Schools Education Foundation Scholarship Program

PURPOSE

The Harold E. Henson Sr. Scholarship Fund provides support to students whose parents are employed by the Springdale Water Utilities, or are a graduate of an accredited public high school in Springdale pursuing post-secondary education at a two- or four-year college.

USE OF FUNDS

The Henson Scholarship helps deserving students continue their education by providing financial assistance for tuition, books, and associated fees for up to four academic years.

ELIGIBILITY

Qualified applicants must be:

- ◆ Graduating seniors from an accredited public high school in Springdale, **or**
- ◆ Graduating seniors whose parents are employed by the Springdale Water Utilities,
- ◆ Enrolling at a two- or four-year college, and
- ◆ Willing to attend a Springdale Water Utility meeting.

Age, race, sex, marital status or religious affiliation will have no bearing on eligibility for this scholarship.

CRITERIA

The criteria for selection of the scholarship recipient is determined by the selection committee, and may

include, but not limited to, academic performance, financial need, unusual circumstances, and volunteer, work, or extracurricular activities.

AMOUNT OF SCHOLARSHIP

The amount of the scholarship is \$1,500. Changes to the scholarship amount may be determined by the Foundation based on factors including, but not limited to, the amount of dollars available from the fund.

RENEWABLE

This scholarship may be renewable for up to four years, providing the student maintains a 2.5 academic achievement level and remains a full-time student, completing 30 credit hours per academic year.

APPLICATION PROCESS

The application process is as follows:

1. You must complete the online application by April 1st.
2. The selection committee will review applications.
3. The recipient will be notified of final scholarship decisions at the senior assembly.
4. The recipient must attend the Donor & Scholar Reception during the first week of June.
