SUZANNE GRAHAM MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINES

Springdale Public Schools Education Foundation Scholarship Program

PURPOSE

The Suzanne Graham Memorial Scholarship provides support to students who are a graduate of an accredited public high school in Springdale, Arkansas pursuing post-secondary education at a two- or four-year college or vocational school.

USE OF FUNDS

The Suzanne Graham Memorial Scholarship helps deserving students further their education by providing financial assistance for tuition, fees, and books over one academic year.

ELIGIBILITY

Qualified applicants must be:

- Graduating seniors from an accredited public high school in the Springdale Arkansas School District,
- Enrolling at a two- or four-year college, and
- ♦ Have a minimum 2.75 high school GPA.

Age, race, sex, marital status or religious affiliation will have no bearing on eligibility for this scholarship.

CRITERIA

The criteria for selection of the scholarship recipient is determined by the selection committee, and may include, but not limited to, academic

performance, financial need, unusual circumstances, and volunteer, work, or extracurricular activities.

AMOUNT OF SCHOLARSHIP

The amount of the scholarship is \$1,000. Changes to the scholarship amount may be determined by the Foundation based on factors including, but not limited to, the amount of dollars available from the fund.

NONRENEWABLE

This scholarship is a one-time award and is not renewable.

APPLICATION PROCESS

The application process is as follows:

- 1. You must complete the online application by April 1st.
- 2. The selection committee will review applications.
- 3. The recipient will be notified of final scholarship decisions at the senior assembly.
- Recipients must attend the Donors & Scholars Reception during the first week of June.



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
