

# ELMER & DOT JOHNSON SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINES

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## Springdale Public Schools Education Foundation Scholarship Program

### PURPOSE

The Elmer and Dot Johnson Scholarship Fund provides financial support to a graduate of an accredited public high school in Springdale pursuing post-secondary education at a technical school, community college, or university in Arkansas.

### USE OF FUNDS

The Johnson Scholarship helps deserving students continue their education by providing financial assistance for tuition, books, and fees for up to four years.

### ELIGIBILITY

Qualified applicants must be:

- ◆ Graduating seniors from an accredited public high school in Springdale, and
- ◆ Enrolling at a technical school, college, or university in Arkansas.

*Age, race, sex, marital status or religious affiliation will have no bearing on eligibility for this scholarship.*

### CRITERIA

The criteria for selection of the scholarship recipient is determined by the selection committee, and may include, but not limited to, academic performance, financial need, unusual circumstances, and volunteer, work, or extracurricular activities.

### AMOUNT OF SCHOLARSHIP

The amount of the scholarship is \$1,000. Changes to the scholarship amount may be determined by the Foundation based on the amount of dollars available from the fund.

### RENEWABLE

This scholarship may be renewable on an annual basis for a total of four awards, providing the student maintains a 2.5 academic achievement level on a 4.0 Scale and remains a full-time student, completing 30 credit hours per academic year.

### APPLICATION PROCESS

The application process is as follows:

1. You must complete the online application by April 1<sup>st</sup>.
2. The selection committee will review applications.
3. The recipient will be notified of final scholarship decisions at the senior assembly.
4. The recipient must attend the Donor & Scholar Reception during the first week of June.
