

TEX HOLT / SPRINGDALE KIWANIS SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINES

Springdale Public Schools Scholarship Program

PURPOSE

The Tex Holt/Springdale Kiwanis Scholarship provides financial support to a graduate of Springdale High School pursuing post-secondary education.

USE OF FUNDS

The Tex Holt/Springdale Kiwanis Scholarship helps deserving students continue their education by providing financial assistance for tuition, books, and supplies over one academic year.

ELIGIBILITY

Qualified applicants must be:

- Graduating seniors from Springdale High School, and
- Enrolling at a university, college or vocational school.

Age, race, sex, marital status or religious affiliation will have no bearing on eligibility for this scholarship.

CRITERIA

The criteria for selection of the scholarship recipient is determined by the selection committee, and may include, but not limited to, academic performance, financial need, unusual circumstances, and volunteer, work, or extracurricular activities.

AMOUNT OF SCHOLARSHIP

The amount of the scholarship is \$2,000. Changes to the scholarship amount may be determined by the Springdale Kiwanis club based on factors including, but not limited to, the amount of dollars available from the fund.

NON-RENEWABLE

This scholarship is a one-time award and is not renewable.

APPLICATION PROCESS

The application process is as follows:

1. Completed applications and required paperwork are to be submitted online by April 1st.
2. The selection committee will review applications.
3. The recipient will be notified of final scholarship decisions at the senior assembly.
