

MONITOR ELEMENTARY SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINES

Springdale Public Schools Education Foundation Scholarship Program

PURPOSE

The Monitor Elementary Scholarship Fund provides financial support to a graduate of an accredited public high school in the Springdale School District pursuing post-secondary education at a university, community college, or vocational school.

USE OF FUNDS

The Monitor Elementary Scholarship helps deserving students continue their education by providing financial assistance for tuition, books, and associated fees for one year.

ELIGIBILITY

Qualified applicants must be:

- ◆ Students who attended Monitor Elementary for a minimum of 1 year,
- ◆ Graduating seniors from an accredited public high school in the Springdale School District, with a minimum 2.75 GPA and a minimum cumulative ACT score of 21, or an minimum Accuplacer score of 240, and
- ◆ Enrolling in a 2-year or 4-year university, community college, or vocational school.

Age, race, sex, marital status or religious affiliation will have no bearing on eligibility for this scholarship.

CRITERIA

The criteria for selection of the scholarship recipient is determined by the selection committee, and may include, but not limited to, academic performance, financial need, unusual circumstances, volunteer, work, or extracurricular activities.

AMOUNT OF SCHOLARSHIP

The amount of the scholarship is \$500. Changes to the scholarship amount may be determined by the Foundation based on factors including, but not limited to, the amount of dollars available from the fund.

NON-RENEWABLE

This scholarship is a one-time award and may not be renewed.

APPLICATION PROCESS

The application process is as follows:

1. You must complete the online application by April 1st.
2. The selection committee will interview the finalists.
3. The recipient will be notified of final scholarship decisions at the senior assembly.
4. The recipient must attend the Donor & Scholar Reception during the 1st week of June.
