

HAR-BER PTO SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINES

Springdale Public Schools Scholarship Program

PURPOSE

The Har-Ber High School PTO Scholarship Fund provides financial support to a graduating Har-Ber High School Senior, in the current school year, who is planning to attend an accredited college/university or vocational school or trade-related apprenticeship.

USE OF FUNDS

The Har-Ber High School PTO Scholarship helps deserving students continue their education by providing financial assistance for the student's accounts.

ELIGIBILITY

Qualified applicants must be:

1. Graduating seniors from Har-Ber High School;
2. Enrolling in a continuing education program at a college, university, vocational program, or participating in an apprenticeship.

Age, race, sex, marital status or religious affiliation will have no bearing on eligibility for this scholarship.

CRITERIA

The criteria for selection of the scholarship recipient are determined by the selection committee, based on the information provided on the application, and may include, but not limited to, scholarship essay content, scholastic achievement, extracurricular activities, work experience, community involvement, or financial need.

AMOUNT OF SCHOLARSHIP

The amount of the scholarship is up to \$500.

NON-RENEWABLE

This scholarship is not renewable.

APPLICATION PROCESS

The application process is as follows:

1. You must complete the online application by April 1st.
2. This includes:
 - a) Completion of the on-line application process/form,
 - b) Include a copy of your HarBer transcript. This does not need to be an official transcript.
 - c) Include a typed essay of approximately 500 words describing a teacher / class / club / activity / event at Har-Ber High School that had a lasting impact on you and why. Note, using AI to assist in the writing of the essay could result in being disqualified from the scholarship process.
3. The selection committee will review applications and essays.
4. The recipient will be notified of final scholarship decisions at the senior assembly.
